I Sure Missed Going to Prison!

After dedicating most of my adult life to ministering to hundreds of thousands of incarcerated men, women, and teens, the Covid pandemic resulted in prisons across the country being closed to outside volunteer organizations. Then, in 2021, I contracted a near fatal case of the Delta variant myself, which kept me on the sidelines for quite a while.

Since then, I have spent most of my time ministering to at-risk youth through our Living H2O Initiative, pastoring Midway Bible Fellowship, and writing my weekday Dare 2B Daring daily devotional messages. But truth be told, a big part of me remained behind the concrete walls and barbed wire fences where I have

been privileged to minister since 1987.

Just when I thought that my prison ministry days were over, God reopened that door... and when God opens a door, He opens it W-I-D-E! With a newly formed Risk Takers for Christ basketball team, we reached out to 15 different correctional institutions throughout southcentral Florida, and the response has been overwhelming. So overwhelming, in fact, that our schedule is already filled through the end of 2026!

And so, with two veteran players, four rookies, and one nonplaying volunteer, our "new

and improved" RTC basketball team ventured into the Polk Correctional Institution in Polk City on Saturday, November 1st and God moved in a very powerful way. From the minute we passed through security, His anointing was upon the day... and we needed every ounce of it because we were so shorthanded and the prison wanted us to play three games against three different all-star teams.

After an early morning wake-up call and a

two-hour drive across the state, our team started the first game slowly, falling behind by as many as 17 points. But we never gave up... and led by Marty Gradijan's 22 points, we narrowed the gap to just five. Doing so earned the admiration and respect of the prison administration, the other team, and every inmate spectator, which allowed us to share the gospel at halftime

to a very receptive audience. The second game was also closely fought although we ran out of gas at the end. However, our halftime gospel presentation went extremely well and - perhaps energized by the response - we dug deep and won the third game by a wide margin.

Altogether, we distributed an estimated 400 Gospel of Johns with evangelistic tracts inside and saw 10 inmates make first-time professions of faith in Jesus Christ. What a great day of ministry!

As you can see from the team photo on page 1, two of the players were my son Chris and me (and at age 66, I was only there to offer a few "spot minutes" in case of injury or extreme fatigue). The other four players are all new recruits from our Living H2O Initiative, which was extremely gratifying personally. I couldn't have been prouder - not only of the way they played, but also of the way they conducted themselves inside prison for the first time.

The second picture features our squad with one of the inmate teams and the referees, who were inmates themselves (so guess who got all the calls?) Before leaving, we donated two new basketballs and other sports equipment to the institution and promised to make a return visit as soon as possible.
